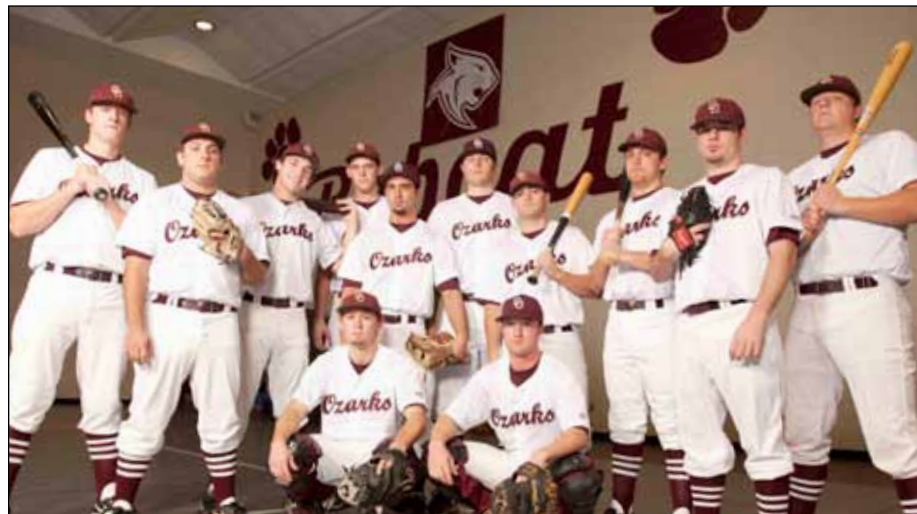


2012 BOBCAT OUTLOOK

The 2012 College of the Ozarks baseball team will return a very talented group of upperclassmen, including 12 seniors who will be taking the field for their final season. This season's team will consist of 13 upperclassmen, all of whom have seen significant time at the college level, mixed in will be an extremely talented group of 7 freshmen. Leadership from the upperclassmen, especially the seniors, will play a big role in the success of the Bobcats for the 2012 season.

Pitching:

The Bobcats will once again look to improve the overall performance on the mound, after seeing this group take significant strides last season. Dustin Loggins, who has been a staff anchor since joining the team as a freshman, will be back for his final season with the Bobcats. The Bobcats look for Dustin to build on his late season success from last season, when he won his last 4 starts. Junior Joel Harrington and Sophomore Timmy Townsend will both once again provide quality and depth to the Bobcats starting rotation as they continue to build on their success from the 2011 season. Other returning senior pitchers include Brad Allen, Colby Arnold, and Willy Hoey, who led the team in appearances last season with 22. Also returning are Dustin Ewers and Dalton Hunter, who both missed last season due to injury. Newcomers to this year's staff include: Josh Neufeld (Nixa High School), Garth Minnick (3 Rivers Community College), Austin Jessen (Crowder College), David Zamora (Southwest Baptist University), and Justin Von Allmen. All five of the newcomers will be looked upon to contribute significant innings immediately.



Catching:

The Bobcats will be sporting a new look behind the plate this season after the graduation of 4 year starter Trent Oxenreider. CofO will not have to look far to find a replacement, as much of the catching load will fall on the shoulders of Trent's brother Daniel Oxenreider. Entering his senior year, Daniel has been a huge asset to the Bobcats as a utility man, but has found a home behind the plate. Senior Nathan Lawrence, and Sophomore Malachi Melton will also see innings behind the plate this season.

Infielders:

The Bobcat infield will be anchored by a group of seniors who have all seen significant time over the first 3 years of their career. Denton Wolf (2 time all conference) will return for his senior season at 2nd base. Denton has been one of the most consistent players in the conference over the past 3 seasons, and will once again be looked upon to pace the Bobcat offense. Senior Nick Lechner will return at 1st base, and will once again be a middle of the lineup run producer for the Bobcats. Josh Maynard will return to the infield for his senior

season, after spending last season in the outfield. Newcomer Malachi Melton (Clarendon Community College) will play 3rd base and catch, and provides a much needed bat to the Bobcat lineup. Other infielders include senior Mark Freed, who will also get at bats as the team DH after producing some big hits as a junior, and Andrew Darby.

Outfield:

This season's group of outfielders will be a good mix of experience and youth. The Bobcats will return senior Dustin Forrest after a breakout offensive season in 2011. Dustin will play leftfield, and provides solid defense and run producing ability at the plate. Sophomore Byron Richardson will be used in both corner outfield spots, after seeing his first action in the outfield last season. Freshman Cody Pentecost and Tyler Lopez will both see plenty of action in the outfield this spring as well. Cody is a tremendous outfielder who will hit in the top of the Bobcats order. Tyler also provides great defense and will be a mainstay in the Bobcats lineup.

BJ Curry

Assistant Head Coach

BJ Curry is in his second year as assistant coach, after spending three years coaching and teaching at the high school level. Coach Curry spent a year coaching at Wheaton High School where he led the baseball team to a conference title, following a two year stay coaching baseball and basketball at Exeter High School. Coach Curry is a 2007 graduate of College of the Ozarks, receiving a degree in Physical Educa-

tion, and was a four year starter for the Bobcats on the field. During his baseball career he was honored as a member of the All-Conference team his sophomore and junior seasons. He is the College of the Ozarks single season leader in walks, and second in runs scored, and stolen bases. He also holds the career record for runs scored. Coach Curry's primary responsibility is working with hitters and infielders. Coach Curry and his wife, Natalie, reside in Ozark.

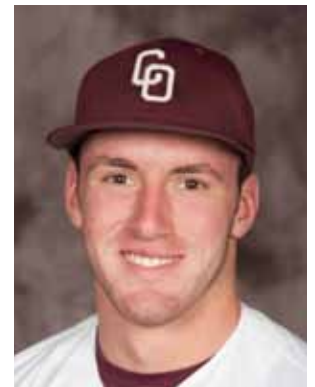

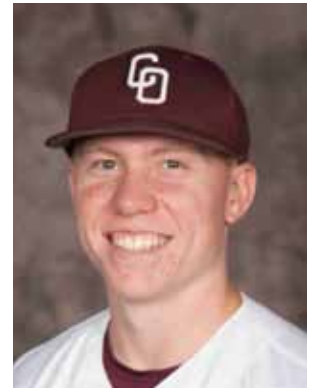

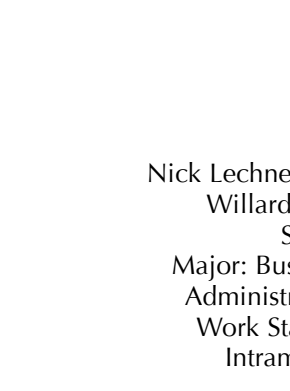
