#### STEPS FOR APPLYING FOR ADMISSION TO THE STUDENT TEACHING PROGRAM OF COLLEGE OF THE OZARKS

Requirements you must have before admission to Student Teaching Program:

- 1. You must have been admitted to the Teacher Education Program.
- 2. You must have at <u>least</u> a 2.7\* GPA in your major field.
- 3. No grade less than a 'C-' in required education (professional) and major (content) field courses.
- 4. You must have at least a 2.7\* Cumulative GPA.
- 5. You must have completed all course requirements except for Teacher Assistant and Student Teaching, or made prior arrangements with Dr. Swofford.

Required forms you must have on file in the Education Department <u>before</u> your application is taken to the Teacher Education Committee:

- 1. The **COLLEGE OF THE OZARKS APPLICATION FOR STUDENT TEACHING** form, filled out in its entirety. Be sure to obtain your advisor's signature and date, as well as the signature of your major department's Teacher Education Committee representative and date. If your advisor is also the committee representative for the department, he/she may sign on the advisor line and on the TE Committee line or you may ask another committee member to sign.
- 2. The **AFFIDAVIT OF MORAL CHARACTER FOR TEACHER CERTIFICATION PURPOSES MISSOURI** form, filled out in its entirety and *signed in the presence of* a notary public.
- 3. The **STUDENT TEACHER APPLICANT'S CURRENT COURSES AND COURSES LACKING** form must be filled out in its entirety. It must be signed by Dr. Swofford <u>if</u> you have any courses other than EDU441 and 45V outstanding.
- 4. One **TEACHER DISPOSITIONS** rubric completed by your advisor.
- 5. One **TEACHER DISPOSITIONS** rubric completed by a faculty member in your major field who is aware of your academic and professional growth.

Items required prior to Student Teaching (but not required for ST Program application process):

- You must have passed the state-designated exit exam (currently Praxis) in your specialty area for the state of Missouri.
- 2. You must have proof of **PERSONAL LIABILITY INSURANCE.** This insurance is available through S-MSTA for members. Contact an S-MSTA Officer or the Education Office for further information.
- 3. You must have your **Fingerprinting/Criminal Background Check** completed and proof provided to the Education Office.

It should also be noted that any student entering the teacher education program in Fall 2013 or following will be required to document a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75, a minimum content GPA of 3.0, and a minimum professional education GPA of 3.0 by the completion of the program in order to obtain teacher certification in Missouri.

<sup>\*</sup>Unless C-BASE exam was taken for the first time prior to August. 27, 2012, in which case minimum GPA will be 2.6 for Student Teacher Program.
