Application Process

Requirements you must have before admission to Student Teaching Program:

- Admitted to the Teacher Education Program
- Minimum of 3.0 GPA in your major field. No grade less than a C- in required education (professional) and major (content field courses)
- Minimum of 2.75 Cumulative GPA.
- Completed all course requirements except for Teacher Assistant (EDU441) and Student Teaching (EDU45V), or made prior arrangements with Dr. Swofford, Director of Teacher Education.

Required forms/documentation you must have on file in the Education Department <u>before</u> your application is taken to the Teacher Education Committee:

- Application for Student Teaching form, filled out in its entirety. Be sure to obtain your advisor's signature and date, as well as the signature of your major department's Teacher Education Committee representative and date. If your advisor is also the committee representative for the department, he/she may sign on the advisor line and on the TE Committee line or you may ask another committee member to sign.
- Affidavit of Moral Character for Teacher Certification Purposes Missouri form, filled out in its entirety and signed in the presence of a notary public (form may be notarized on campus by Deborah Lyon, 3rd floor Nursing Department; Diana Winkle, Dean of Admissions office; Vicki Wrosch, Business office).
- Student Teacher Applicant's Current Courses and Courses Lacking form must be filled out in its entirety. It must be signed by Dr. Swofford, Director of Teacher Education, only if you have any courses other than EDU 441 and 45V outstanding.
- **Teacher Dispositions** rubric (one) completed by your advisor.
- **Teacher Disposition** rubric (one) completed by a faculty member in your major field who is aware of your academic and professional growth.
- S-MSTA Online Membership documentation. Apply at: www.msta.org/join, or after each S-MSTA meeting, officers will be available to help you with the online process in McKibben Computer Lab. This online membership provides required liability insurance for the student teacher. Online cost: FREE. Joining S-MSTA also gives you the benefit of a discounted MSTA membership your first year of teaching, as well as other professional development opportunities. Please submit a second copy of your online verification, along with \$5.00 chapter dues, to the Education Office or when you attend an S-MSTA meeting. Meeting dates are posted on the Event Calendar in the Education Department.
- **Brown Card** from Cash Accounts confirming your current banked hours (280 banked hours are recommended before you begin student teaching).

Items required prior to Student Teaching (but not required for ST Program application process):

- Missouri Content Assessment Results (state-designated exit exam) submitted to the Education office. It is your responsibility to check with the Education office to be certain it is on file. Register at: www.mo.nesinc.com under TEST tab select Missouri Content Assessment. Cost: Varied
- Fingerprinting/Criminal Background Check completed and receipt submitted to the Education office. Instructions and information can be found on the attached document.
