

Association of Government Accountants Ozarks Chapter

2019-2020 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Ozarks Chapter of the Association of Government Accountants (AGA) supports the careers and professional development of government finance professionals working in state and local governments as well as the private sector and academia in the Southwest Missouri region.

Up to two \$500 individual scholarships will be awarded.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM PURPOSE:

- 1. To promote and reward academic achievement by students whose goals include obtaining a college degree with a major in Accountancy, Business Administration, or closely related field and who are committed to entering the accounting profession.
- 2. To provide financial assistance to deserving students.
- 3. To promote constructive citizenship activity among members of the Ozarks Chapter AGA.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

- 1. The applicant must be enrolled with a declared major or masters as mentioned above at Drury University, Evangel University, Southwest Baptist University, Missouri State University, College of the Ozarks, Missouri Southern State University, or completing undergraduate studies at Ozarks Technical Community College or Crowder College.
- 2. An applicant may apply for a scholarship during any year of his/her enrollment in one of the universities or colleges indicated above.
- 3. A freshman must have a composite ACT score of at least 27 or an SAT score of at least 1220 and have a grade point average of at least 3.0 on all college hours earned. The applicant must be enrolled in at least 12 hours during the semester when the application is submitted.
- 4. An undergraduate other than a freshman must have accumulated at least 12 hours each semester throughout his/her tenure as a college student and have at least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average. The applicant must be enrolled in at least 12 hours during the semester when the application is submitted.
- 5. A graduate enrolled in a master's program as described above must be enrolled in at least 9 credit hours during the semester when the application is submitted and have graduated with a cumulative undergraduate grade point average of at least 3.0.
- 6. Applicants attending College of the Ozarks may apply for a textbook reimbursement scholarship.
