The Heart of the Ozarks chapter of the Oncology Nursing Society will award four scholarships annually, two for the spring semester and two for the fall semester. Each award will be for \$500.00 and will be designated for educational expenses for the recipient. The purpose is to encourage education for students with an interest in oncology, palliative care, hospice.

The award will be publicized on the ONS website and information will be provided to local nurse managers and educational institutions. Our goal is for the award to be available to local nurses/students whether they are in a local school or an online university.

Eligible students must already be enrolled in an accredited institution that offers a nursing degree and provide proof of enrollment. Both full time and part time students may apply. Applicants may not be 1st year students.


